# Fordham Army ROTC: Compete for Scholarships

- Scholarships cover 100% tuition and fees
- \$1,200 per year for books
- \$420 per month in stipend
- Fordham has offered a room waiver for 3, 3.5, and 4 year scholarship winners
- Marist College, SUNY Maritime, and The King's College offer similar benefits



# Fordham Army ROTC: The Schedule

- Participate in physical training on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday early mornings.
- Students participate in a lab and class once a week on Wednesdays. ROTC Cadets enjoy priority academic registration
- NCAA Division I-III and club sport athletes can be excused from ROTC training if there are conflicts
- If you work part-time or full-time we can try to work with your schedule
