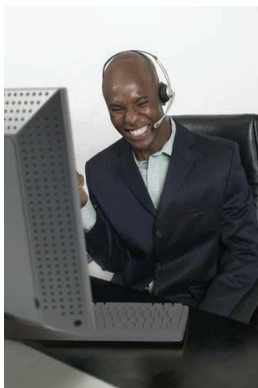
What is Adult Education?
