### Institutional Refund Policy

For the 2019-2020 academic year, tuition in the School of Professional and Continuing Studies is assessed at \$915.00 per credit hour.

The following refund policies are based on 100-percent payment of all institutional charges for the enrollment period. The refund period begins on the first day of the enrollment period.

#### Institutional Refund Policy (Tuition)

Date of Withdrawal	Due Fordham	Refund
Prior to start of term	0%	100%
Prior to second week of term**	15%	85%
Prior to third week of term	30%	70%
Prior to fourth week of term	45%	55%
Prior to fifth week of term	60%	40%
Prior to sixth week of term	75%	25%
Thereafter	100%	0%

**\*\*The add/drop period for each school within the University is approximately 7 days into the term.** During this period changes in course work is permitted with no tuition penalty. However, if a student withdraws from the University during the add/drop period, the tuition liability will be calculated based on the above table.
