## Room Assignment Information

To be eligible for summer housing (either session), you must be a) matriculated and in good standing at an accredited American college or university, b) registered for at least three credits and attending the class during the session, and c) 18 years of age by the move-in date. Housing at Rose Hill is in air-conditioned rooms designed to accommodate two people. Housing at Lincoln Center is in two- and three-bedroom apartments with kitchens and air conditioning. At Lincoln Center, a majority of students will be housed in double bedrooms; however, a limited number of single bedrooms may be available upon request. Single bedrooms cannot be guaranteed. You will be notified of your assignment by email. Housing rates will be finalized by March 30. See [fordham.edu/summer](http://fordham.edu/summer) for updates.

**Please check all sessions for which you are applying to stay in summer housing. All move dates and times are final.** Those who do not adhere to the move dates may be subject to disciplinary action, including fines and lock charges.

### SUMMER SESSION I | MAY 26–JUNE 25

Move in for Lincoln Center is May 24 between noon and 6 p.m.; move in for Rose Hill is May 22 between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.  
Move out at both campuses is June 26 before noon.
