POSITION DESCRIPTION

LECTURER (Chemistry). The Fordham School of Professional & Continuing Studies invites applicants for a full time, non-tenure track Lecturer position to teach in the Department of Natural Sciences at Fordham University (Lincoln Center campus). The successful candidate will be an effective and enthusiastic teacher with a commitment to supporting a diverse population of post-baccalaureate/pre-health and adult undergraduate students. This position is a full-time, benefitted position.

Responsibilities:

Teaching responsibilities include General Chemistry I and II, Organic Chemistry I and II with the possibility of teaching core physical science and chemistry labs, at the department's discretion. The course load requirement is four courses per semester. Courses are taught in-person and this position requires relocation. Courses for this position are targeted to the post-baccalaureate program and include Post-baccalaureate/Pre-Health adult students. Courses are held in the evenings, and some courses may be held on the weekends and at our Rose Hill campus in the Bronx. Mentoring or student support activities to help build our community and levels of student satisfaction.

REQUIREMENTS

Required Qualifications:

- Ph.D. (or ABD) in Chemistry or a related physical science or a master's in Chemical Engineering.
- Demonstrated interest, experience, and potential for excellence in teaching general or organic chemistry at the undergraduate level.
- Comfort with teaching an adult student population and an understanding of Fordham's mission and values.
- Demonstrated ability to apply a culturally responsive and flexible approach that is supportive to the diverse needs of PCS students, faculty, and staff.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Minimum of 2 years teaching at the college level.
- Experience teaching both General Chemistry and Organic Chemistry and the associated labs.
