Maggie Wittlin

Associate Professor of Law



Maggie Wittlin’s research focuses on evidence, as well as criminal and civil procedure, intellectual property, and law and behavioral sciences. Using theoretical, mathematical, and empirical methods, she studies how legal actors—judges, jurors, and citizens—should and do use evidence to make decisions.

Wittlin is a co-author of *The New Wigmore, A Treatise on Evidence: Expert Evidence, Third Edition*, and a co-organizer of the Evidence Summer Workshop. She previously taught at the University of Nebraska College of Law, where she was twice voted IL Professor of the Year. She was an Associate in Law at Columbia Law School prior to that. Before teaching, she practiced at Patterson Belknap Webb & Tyler. She clerked for the Honorable Raymond J. Lohier Jr., of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit and the Honorable Robert N. Chatigny of the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut.

Meagan Crowley-Hsu '07 is director and senior privacy counsel at Saks, where she counsels on enterprise privacy and data security practices, policies, and compliance protocols to protect customers, employees, and business partners.

At Fordham Law, Crowley-Hsu draws on her practical experience to teach Legal Writing and Research to first-year students. Crowley-Hsu previously worked at Thomson Reuters, first as deputy editor of Practical Law The Journal: Litigation, and later as a Practical Law privacy and data security editor. While at Thomson Reuters, she received multiple awards for her work developing resources on complex litigation and privacy issues and trends for legal professionals, as well as for her involvement with employee resource groups. Before Thomson Reuters, she practiced law as senior litigation associate at Reed Smith and as litigation associate at Debevoise & Plimpton, where she focused her practice on complex commercial litigation and white-collar and regulatory investigations. She clerked for the late Honorable Joel A. Pisano of the U.S. District Court of the District of New Jersey.

Director of Public Interest Scholars & Fellowships, Public Interest Resource Center



Aisha Baruni counsels students and alumni on all aspects of the public interest job search and organizes programs and events for the Fordham community. She runs the Stein Scholars Program in Public Interest Law & Ethics. Additionally, she works closely with students and alumni pursuing post-graduate public interest fellowships.

For almost ten years prior to coming to Fordham, Baruni worked as a civil legal services attorney representing low- and moderate-income homeowners facing foreclosure, many of whom had predatory mortgage loans. She began this work in Philadelphia, as an Independence Foundation Fellow at Community Legal Services of Philadelphia, and continued it in New York at Queens Legal Services (part of Legal Services NYC). Prior to her direct legal services work, Aisha clerked for the Honorable James T. Giles of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and for the Honorable William L. Chapman Jr., and the Honorable Michael K. Newell of the Delaware Family Court. Baruni graduated magna cum laude from Temple University Beasley School of Law, where she was a Rubin Public Interest Scholar, and received her bachelor's degree with high honors from Swarthmore College.

Toni M. Jaeger-Fine is assistant dean of international and non-J.D. programs at Fordham Law School. She has taught or lectured domestically and in Argentina, Brazil, China, Colombia, Croatia, Czech Republic, Dominican Republic, Egypt, Germany, Italy, Japan, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Mexico, the Netherlands, Nigeria, Peru, Romania, Spain, Switzerland, Taiwan, and Vietnam. Dean Jaeger-Fine is the author of numerous articles on a wide range of topics published in the United States and abroad, as well as several books: *Becoming a Lawyer: Discovering and Defining Your Professional Persona*; *American Legal Systems: A Resource and Reference Guide*; *An Introduction to the Anglo-American Legal System* (which has been translated into Italian, Korean, and Portuguese); *The U.S. LL.M.: From Whether to When, What, Where, and How*; and *Mastering the U.S. Legal System*. Jaeger-Fine blogs online at YourProfessionalPersona.com. She is a regular speaker to delegations hosted by the U.S. Department of State, senior counselor to the International Section of the Federal Bar Association, and an application reader for the Schwarzman Scholars program.

Previously, Jaeger-Fine served as associate director of the global law program at New York University School of Law. She was twice a Fulbright Senior Specialist Program grant recipient and is past chair of the sections on Post-Graduate Legal Education, International Legal Exchange, and Legal Education for Foreign Lawyers of the Association of American Law Schools. Jaeger-Fine was associated with the law firm of Crowell & Moring in Washington, D.C., where her practice focused on commercial, appellate, and administrative litigation. She graduated cum laude from Duke Law School and received her bachelor's degree from Harpur College, where she was elected to Phi Beta Kappa.

DOCTOR OF LAWS

Laura Taylor Swain

Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York



Throughout her long career on the federal bench, Laura Taylor Swain, Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, has presided with focus and integrity over complicated, high-profile cases involving financial fraud, health care, immigration, the environment, and bankruptcy. Widely regarded as a deliberate and insightful jurist, she is celebrated by prosecutors and plaintiffs' and defense attorneys alike for her fearlessness in issuing major rulings, and for consistently rendering justice equally and impartially, with an abiding fidelity to the rule of law.

Born in Brooklyn, New York, she graduated from Hunter College High School in 1975 before earning a bachelor's degree in government cum laude at Harvard University's Radcliffe College in 1979 and a Juris Doctor degree at Harvard Law School three years later. She began her legal career in 1982 as a clerk for the trailblazing civil rights strategist and litigator Constance Baker Motley, then Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. In the 1950s and 1960s, Motley was a key member of the team that litigated *Brown v. Board of Education* and many other groundbreaking cases challenging Jim Crow laws. She was the first Black woman to argue before the Supreme Court, and she later became the first Black woman appointed to the federal bench. In 2018, Judge Swain paid tribute to her mentor: "She [worked] to make a world in which everyone had the opportunity to excel and to serve, and I think that's what each of us should do. That's certainly what I seek to do every day."

For more than a decade, Judge Swain practiced at Debevoise & Plimpton, where she focused on employee benefits, compensation, and employment law. In 1986, she joined the New York State Board of Law Examiners, becoming the first woman and the first person of color to serve on that board. She began her tenure on the federal bench in 1996 as a judge of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of New York, where she managed a docket of more than 6,000 cases. In 2000, President Bill Clinton appointed her to the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York.

From the bench of one of the nation's premier legal institutions, she has presided over numerous prominent cases, including the criminal prosecution of several former employees of Bernard L. Madoff Investment Securities. In 2017, Chief Justice John G. Roberts appointed her to oversee the debt restructuring cases in the Puerto Rican government-debt crisis, the first-ever bankruptcy-like case of a U.S. territory.

For her distinguished contributions to the bench and her faithful stewardship of public trust and confidence in the law, we, the President and Trustees of Fordham University, in solemn convocation assembled and in accord with the chartered authority bestowed on us by the Regents of the University of the State of New York, declare Laura Taylor Swain Doctor of Laws, honoris causa. That she may enjoy all rights and privileges of this, our highest honor, we have issued these letters patent under our hand and the corporate seal of the University on this, the 21st day of May in the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty-Two.

This degree will be presented at the School of Law diploma ceremony on 23 May 2022.
