## **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

The Division of Curriculum & Teaching (C&T) in the Graduate School of Education at Fordham University is seeking a clinical faculty (non-tenure track) member who coordinates and teaches in its nationally recognized TESOL/Bilingual Education and Childhood Education programs. The position requires productive teaching, effective program coordination, and collaboration with the faculty in the Division.

### **Position Responsibilities**

#### *Teaching*

The faculty in this position will teach 24 credits at the graduate level during the academic year (fall/spring). The faculty may have an opportunity to teach in the summer with a separate contract.

#### *Program Coordination in the Division of Curriculum & Teaching*

1. Serve as Program Coordinator of the TESOL and Bilingual Education programs/Childhood Education programs.
2. Recruit candidates and revitalize enrollment in the TESOL and Bilingual Education and Childhood Education programs.
3. Review applications of candidates in the TESOL and Bilingual Education programs and Childhood Education.
4. Advise teacher candidates in the TESOL, Bilingual Education programs and Childhood Education programs.
5. Participate in Information Sessions and other recruitment activities.
6. Oversee teacher candidates' field experiences.
7. Identify, orient, and evaluate adjunct faculty and field specialists in the TESOL, Bilingual Education and Childhood Education programs.
8. Assume a leadership role in the accreditation of the TESOL, Bilingual Education, and Childhood Education programs.
9. Collaborate with colleagues in the division in data collection and management for accreditation.
10. Conducts research and works with students at both graduate and doctoral levels.
11. Communicate with candidate for teaching certification requirements.
12. Attend meetings at divisional and school levels.
13. Conduct additional duties Division Chair may assign.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

### **Required Qualifications**

- Master's degree in a field related to TESOL, Bilingual Education, or Childhood Education
- Must hold teaching certification, or be eligible for teacher certification, in TESOL, Bilingual Education, or Childhood Education



- At least three years of teaching experience in P-12 education in TESOL, Bilingual Education, or Childhood Education

## **Preferred Qualifications**

- Doctoral degree in a field related to TESOL, Bilingual Education, or Childhood Education.
- Knowledgeable of teacher education and online teaching.
- Understanding of professional and scholarly collaboration within diverse and interdisciplinary contexts.
- Professional preparation and/or experience in at least one of the following areas: TESOL/Multilingual Education; Childhood Education.
