



REPORT OF ACTION BY THE FACULTY SENATE

May 5, 2014

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Senate President *pro tempore* Grace Vernon at 5:21 p.m. in Viewing Room #041 of the Walsh Library.

Election of Faculty Senate Officers, 2014–2015

President *pro tempore* Vernon read the sections of the Senate's by-laws concerning the election of officers and appointed tellers and recorders for the election.

President *pro tempore* Vernon then opened nominations for the position of President for academic year 2014–2015. There were two nominations: Mary Ann Forgey (nominated by Clark, seconded by Cohen) and William Baumgarth (nominated by Balestra, seconded by Saharia). Forgey received 14 votes; Baumgarth 6. President *pro tempore* Vernon declared Forgey the winner of the election.

President *pro tempore* Vernon then opened nominations for the position of Vice President. There was one nomination: Andrew H. Clark (nominated by Forgey, seconded by Hornbeck). Clark received 18 affirmative votes, with 2 votes in the negative. President *pro tempore* Vernon declared Clark the winner of the election.

President *pro tempore* Vernon then opened nominations for the position of Secretary. There was one nomination: Patrick Hornbeck (nominated by McGee, seconded by Cohen). Hornbeck received 18 affirmative votes, with 2 votes in the negative. President *pro tempore* Vernon declared Hornbeck the winner of the election.

Newly elected President Forgey appointed as at-large members of the Executive Committee Senators James Cohen and Margo Jackson.

Resolutions concerning Lecturers

The Senate approved (20-0-0) the following resolution (Clark/Nissim):

The Faculty Senate expresses its dismay at the Administration's failure to place on the agenda of the Board of Trustees the statutes on Lecturers approved at the December 13, 2013, meeting of the Faculty Senate, as the incorporation of the proposed language into the Statutes will improve instruction and the academic experience and make the administration of the institution more efficient.

The Senate then approved (20-0-0) the following resolution (Clark/Keller):

The Senate is also dismayed by the failure of the Administration to renew lecturer contracts for the 2014–2015 academic year in a timely manner, which has resulted in the loss of talented instructional staff.
