June 22, 2006:

To reaffirm accreditation, and to commend the institution for the quality of the self-study report; and to request that the [next] Periodic Review Report, due 1 June 2011, document further progress in (1) integrating the mission into institutional planning processes, (2) ensuring student information literacy, and (3) implementing the plan and processes for the assessment of student learning.

Brief History Since Last Comprehensive Evaluation:

November 15, 2000:

To accept the Periodic Review Report, to reaffirm accreditation, and to request a follow-up report by October 1, 2002 documenting the development and implementation of a comprehensive institutional strategic plan which links long-range planning to decision-making and budgetary processes. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2004-2005.

June 20, 2001:

To accept the report submitted by the institution and to include the Marymount College campus within the scope of the institution's accreditation, effective July 1, 2002. To remind the institution that a follow-up report is due October 1, 2002 documenting the development and implementation of a comprehensive institutional strategic plan which links long-range planning to decision-making and budgetary processes. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2004-2005.

November 20, 2002:

To acknowledge receipt of the follow-up report. To request that the self--Study, in preparation for the 2004-2005 evaluation visit, document progress in the development and implementation of a comprehensive institutional strategic plan.

March 3, 2003:

Institution granted a delay in evaluation visit now scheduled for 2005-2006.
