



REPORT OF ACTION BY THE FACULTY SENATE
March 24, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Senate President Anne E. Fernald at 12:37 p.m. in McMahon Hall #109, Lincoln Center Campus.

Senator Hornbeck moved, seconded by Senator Vernon:

To accept provisionally the proposed changes to the Lecturer statutes pending final approval of minor amendments to be circulated.

The motion was approved (19/1/0).

Senator McGee moved, seconded by Senator Rubin:

The Senate directs the Senate Executive Committee to recruit and engage faculty subcommittee chairs to enact specific activities to respond to the Administration's proposed health care cuts by March 29th.

Senator Hornbeck offered an amendment to the motion, accepted by Senator McGee and seconded by Senator Baumgarth, proposing the addition of the following phrase to its conclusion:

...and, specifically, directs the Senate Executive Committee to organize a campaign of faculty letter writing to the President, Board of Trustees, and senior administrators.

Senator Hornbeck moved, seconded by Senator Rodriguez, to close the debate on the amendment to Senator McGee's motion.

The motion was approved (20/0/0).

Senate President Anne E. Fernald called for a vote to approve the amendment (Hornbeck/Baumgarth) to the motion (McGee/Rubin).

The motion was approved (18/1/0).

Senate President Anne E. Fernald called for a vote on the motion (McGee/Rubin) as amended (Hornbeck/Baumgarth).

The Senate directs the Senate Executive Committee to recruit and engage faculty subcommittee chairs to enact specific activities to respond to the Administration's proposed health care cuts by March 29th and, specifically, directs the Senate Executive Committee to organize a campaign of faculty letter writing to the President, Board of Trustees, and senior administrators.

The motion was approved (18/1/0).
