

Duplicate Diploma Request Form

(Non-Law School Students Only)

Regulations Governing Duplicate Diplomas:

- 1. Payment: Duplicate diplomas are printed twice a year (January and July). The fee for a Duplicate Diploma is (effective 7/1/2024) \$78 (check or money order payable to Fordham University), which includes domestic mail service, if requested. Orders take up to eight weeks to be processed. Please complete this form and return it along with payment to the address below. **Please note: If you have a financial obligation to the University, your duplicate diploma request CANNOT be honored. Additionally, the university will need to verify graduation award status prior to processing the check payment or duplicate diploma request.
- 2. <u>Mailing</u>: Diplomas are sent by way of the United States Postal Service (USPS). No PO boxes. An additional charge of \$26 applies if the request is to mail the diploma to an international address. The Office of Academic Records does not recommend mailing a diploma overseas since, historically, diplomas do not reach their destination and are not traceable after they leave the U.S.
