AI for Cybersecurity

Provides a background in data science and cybersecurity. Can be attended on a part-time basis. 15 credit (5 course) program. Rolling admissions.

Health Care Ethics

Provides a background in current ethical controversies on policy-relevant issues in health care. 12 credit (4 course) program, with a capstone course culminating in a mentored paper.

<u>Humanitarian Training Courses</u> (Hybrid)

Individual courses, each of which provide a background in some aspect of humanitarian crises and disasters. Course topics vary by semester.

International Diploma in Humanitarian Assistance

Intensive, four-week course with the <u>Institute of International Humanitarian Affairs</u>. Dates and locations vary by year.

Medieval Studies

Doctoral-level certificate. Provides an interdisciplinary concentration for those working on the Medieval period. 15 credit (5 course) program, including a course in Latin paleography. Must demonstrate a reading knowledge of Latin (and Greek where appropriate) as well as two modern languages other than English. Must pass comprehensive exams in the two areas of specialization. **Provides eligibility to apply for a second senior teaching fellowship, which provides an additional year of funding.**

Rhetoric and Writing

Provides an interdisciplinary approach to the study of discourse and its impact on culture, politics, and everyday life. 12 credit (4 course) program.
